

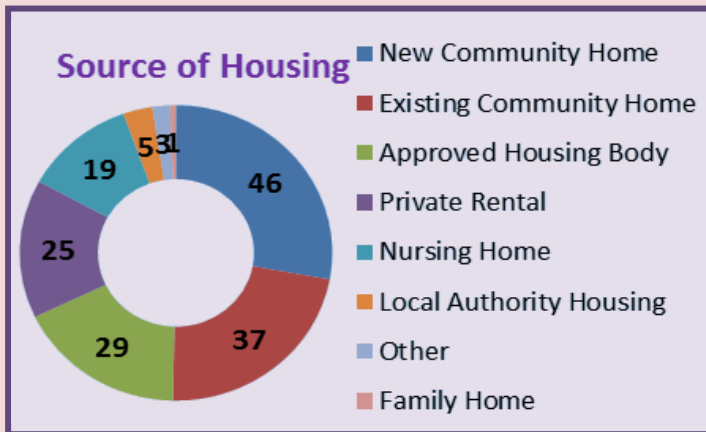
Progress made under Time to Move on Policy in 2018



165 people transitioned to the community

33 people were admitted or re-admitted



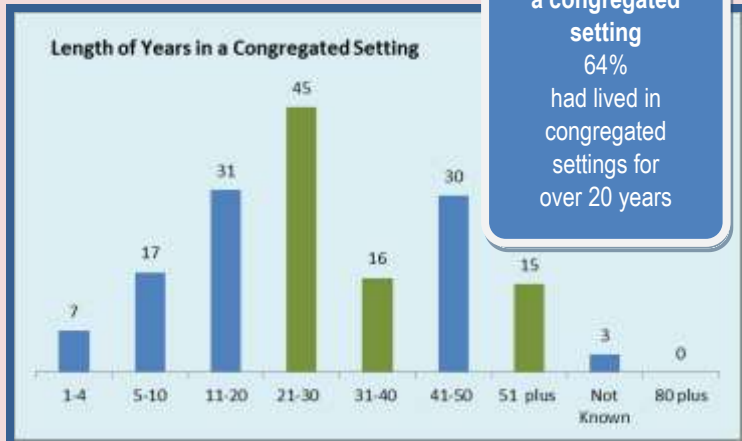
30 people who moved had high medical support needs

83 Centres

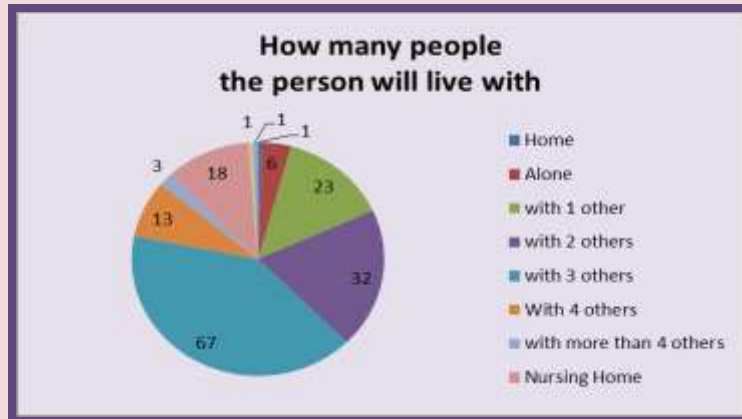
2,136 People in Congregated Settings
