

Layout of the Hospital

Sligo General Hospital was originally built in the 1940's on the site of an old Fever Hospital. Further developments were carried out in the 1960's culminating with the construction of the current Multi-Storey Building which opened in 1991. The 1940's and 1960's building have been significantly upgraded with corridors linking the new and the old buildings.

The lay out of the hospital currently is as follows:

Level 1

Medical Records, HIPE, Consumer Services (including Complaints) and National Cancer Registry

Level 2

CSSD, Catering, Staff Canteen and Public Restaurant and Cardiac Catherisation Laboratories.

Level 3

Main Entrance and Reception, Switchboard, Admissions , Church, Emergency Department, Radiology, Acute Assessment Unit and Hematology Oncology Departments, Security, General Management, Nursing Management, Personnel, Salaries, Clinical Administration, Physiotherapy, Out Patients, Audiology, Orthoptist/Community Ophthalmic, Social Work, Nutrition and Dietetics, Heart Failure, Phlebotomy, Genito Urinary Medicine, Pre Admission Clinic and Renal Dialysis.

Level 4

Obstetrics, Delivery Suites, Early Pregnancy Assessment Unit, Cardiac Investigations, Cardiac Rehabilitation, Dermatology, Endoscopy, Diabetic Service, Pharmacy, Occupational Therapy, Laboratory, Information Technology Pulmonary Function Testing, DEXA Scanning/Tilt Table and Neurophysiology

Level 5

Medical North and South, Coronary Care Unit, Ophthalmology, Orthopaedic and ENT

Level 6

Surgical North, Surgical/Gynaecology, Day Services, Oncology Day Unit, Library/Research and Education Centre.

Level 7

Medical 7 and Paediatrics

Level 8

General Theatres, Anaesthesia, Intensive Care Unit and Stroke Unit.

In addition the following services are provided outside of the main building:-

Tissue Viability, Stoma Care, Nutrition and Dietetics, Quality, Health Promotion, Smoking Cessation, Medical Manpower, Capital Projects, Clinical Audit, Support Services, Maintenance, Quality, PPARS, Surgical Stores, Social Work, Ambulance, and Mortuary.

Other services provided in houses on or adjacent to the campus include:-

Orthodontics, Oral Maxillofacial, Child Psychiatry, Palliative Care, Finance, Pain Control, Nursing Practice and Development Unit. Also on the campus, with a direct link to the hospital is the North West Hospice Unit.
