

**THIS CLINIC AT BAGGOT ST HOSPITAL IS FOR GAY, BISEXUAL MEN AND MEN WHO HAVE SEX WITH MEN (MSM) AND FOR TRANSGENDER PEOPLE. IT IS FREE, FRIENDLY AND CONFIDENTIAL.**

ON TUESDAYS & WEDNESDAYS we provide; full STI Screening, blood tests for HIV, Syphilis and Hepatitis. The Hepatitis Vaccine. Treatment for genital warts or herpes etc. Also PEP (prevention treatment for recent exposure to HIV-within 72 hours). Counselling, support, information and advice is available also. The **doors open** at 5.00pm, registration begins at 5.30pm, and the clinic begins between 5.45pm and 6.00pm. *Note this is a sexual health clinic you will be referred for any other medical health matters.*

**YOUR FIRST VISIT DETAILS:** You are given a **number** and you will be called by this number to talk to a member of staff and to be **registered**. The clinic can be very busy, so depending on your number your first visit could last from 45 to 120 minutes. *We try to see everyone before 8.15pm.* NOTE: Other people attending this clinic may have return appointments and they will see the doctor, before those with numbers. *Each Doctor will see 12 clients.*

**WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?** A member of staff will direct you to be **registered**. The receptionist will call your number. You will be asked for your name, address and especially for a contact mobile telephone number; date of birth; and where born (Country if born abroad or what County if born in Ireland). You will be asked to indicate your ethnic identity. *All of this information is confidential to this clinic only. We use the mobile number to send your results by SMS or for reminders of further appointment etc.* You will receive a card with your **reference number**, hold on to it or write your number somewhere or insert into your mobile telephone under gmhscode.
