 Care Attendants were performing both care and welfare duties simultaneously with laundry duties.

Required Action:

Laundry staff to be appointed for laundry duties only.

Timescale:

■ Immediately.

Article: <u>REGISTER AND RECORDS</u>

In every nursing home there shall be kept in a safe place a bound register of all dependent persons resident in the home, which shall include the following particulars in respect of each person:

(e) where the person has left the nursing home, the date on which he or she left and a forwarding address;

Breach:

Some medical noted were not signed by the medical practitioner

Required Action:

All medical notes to be signed by the GP.

Your immediate attention to this report is requested.

Timescale:

2 weeks

Recommendations:

• Electric overlay high risk mattress to be put in place for the two residents with pressure sores.
