

Environmental Health Officer (Grade Code 319X)

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Environmental Health Officer**.

1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

- (a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:
 - (i) Possess a B.Sc (Environmental Health) Level 8 Dublin Institute of Technology

or

(ii) Possess a B Sc. Degree Level 8 - University of Dublin and a Diploma in Environmental Health –Dublin Institute of Technology

or

(iii) Possess a Diploma in Health Inspection awarded prior to 10th December 1982, and recognised by the Minister for Health

or

 (iv) Possess a non-Irish professional qualification in Environmental Health, recognised by the Minister for Health

and

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite professional and technical knowledge and ability (including a high standard of suitability and professional ability), for the proper discharge of the office.

2. Age

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where s/he is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

4. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
