1. Professional Qualifications & Experience

Candidates must:-

a) be registered in the Midwives Division of the Register of Nurses kept by An Bord Altranais or be entitled to be so registered

and

b) possess a 3rd level qualification of at least level 7 in nursing, midwifery, education or a health related subject

and

c) have at least 5 years post registration experience of which a minimum of 3 years must be as a midwife

and

d) 2 years experience of working with students in clinical practice

and

e) have completed a Teaching and Assessing course, programme or module or give a commitment to undertake same within 3 months of appointment

and

f) Have the clinical, managerial and administrative capacity to properly discharge the functions of the role.

2. Age Restrictions in Relation to Applications

No age restriction shall apply to a candidate except where he/she is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). In this case the candidate must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

3. Health

A candidate for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

4. Character

Each candidate for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
