

# Dosimetrist, Basic Grade Code 3035

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Dosimetrist, basic** in the HSE.

#### 1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

- (a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:
  - (i) B.Sc (Honours) from the National University of Ireland, University of Dublin, an Institute of Technology, or Dublin City University in which Physics or Therapeutic Radiography/Radiation Therapy was taken as a major subject and honours obtained in that subject. (Level 8 on the Quality & Qualifications Ireland (QQI) framework).

Or

(ii) A B.Sc (Honours) in Radiation Therapy from the University of Dublin. (Level 8 on the Quality & Qualifications Ireland (QQI) framework).

Or

(iii) An equivalent qualification

And

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, including a high standard of suitability), for the proper discharge of the office.

## 2. <u>Age</u>

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where s/he is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

## 3. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

**4.** Character Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
