

# Pharmacist, Senior - National Cancer Control Programme (NCCP) Grade Code 3239

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Pharmacist, Senior – National Cancer Control Programme (NCCP).** 

## 1. Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

- (a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:
  - (i) Are a registered Pharmacist with the Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland (PSI) or be entitled to be so registered.

#### and

(ii) Have at least three years satisfactory post registration experience in either a community **or** a hospital environment, **or** a combination of both.

#### and

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite clinical knowledge and ability (including a high standard of suitability and management ability) for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

#### 2. Annual registration

Practitioners must maintain annual registration on the Pharmacist Register maintained by Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland.

#### 3. <u>Age</u>

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where s/he is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

## 4. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

5. <u>Character</u> Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
