The category of subsistence (Class A or B) is based on the maximum of an individual's salary scale:

Class A	€48,610 and above		
Class B	€48,609 and below		

Expenditure on travel and subsistence should continue to be strictly appraised and monitored. Only esstential travel should be undertaken and the number of officers on any journey should be kept to the absolute minimum.

Please note that any additional costs involved must be met from within your approved allocation.
