Dear Deputy Murphy,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

There are currently no plans in respect of the service users currently residing in the Rosalie Centre.

The Consultant and her Multi Disciplinary Team are currently in the process of conducting a clinical assessment of the Service Users in the Unit. The Team is engaging with family members and Service Users to identify the current and future care needs of these Service Users and their cases will be presented to the Complex Care Committee for consideration.
