Re: **PQ** ref **15560/19** - To ask the Minister for Health the number of elective surgeries and procedures cancelled by specialty at the Midlands Regional Hospital, Tullamore, in each month in 2017, 2018 and to date in 2019, by patient did not attend, self-cancellation and cancellation by hospital.

Dear Deputy,

Further to you recent correspondence, the requested information is contained below.

The Midland Regional Hospital Tullamore is the regional centre for Orthopaedics, ENT, Oncology, Haematology and Renal services for the Midlands and its environs. The number of day cases undertaken in 2018 was 32,899, representing an increase of 1.9% on 2017 activity and 11,592 inpatients. While this represents a slight drop in inpatient discharges over this period (-1.3%), attendances to our Emergency Department increased by 6%. Cancellation of scheduled day case and elective procedures can occur in order to cope with such increases in acute presentations to the Emergency Department. There were also significant weather events in 2018 which resulted in the cancellation of non-urgent scheduled day case and elective procedures during the period. It should also be noted that the March 2019 data suggests that while we experienced unplanned events such as the nursing strike, the Hospital is operating ahead of its inpatient activity of approximately 8.7% while the day case (scheduled) activity in the same period is decreased by 7%.

The Midland Regional Hospital Tullamore always endeavours to avoid cancelling patient treatment, and strive to reschedule cancelled patients as quickly as possible. The Hospital accepts that no person should be waiting prolonged periods for care and treatment and regret where a scheduled appointment is cancelled beyond the control of the Hospital. In managing activity and waiting lists, the Hospital constantly strive to reduce waiting times for all patients and there are many initiatives and pathways being pursued in an effort to meet the ever growing demands on our services. The Hospital also continues to validate waiting lists and would urge all patients unable to attend an appointment that they inform the hospital in a timely manner so the appointment can be offered to another person waiting.
