The Mental Health Commission (MHC) during their registration regulatory visit to Waterford in November commented on significant improvement across a number of MHC Rules and Regulations which had been highlighted as non-compliant in the MHC inspection report in July 2019. Improvements were noted in particular in relation to the regulations pertaining to Premises, Privacy, Staffing, Training, Care Planning and the Rules relating to Seclusion.
