**PQ Question: To ask the Minister for Health the number of staff working in CAMHS; and if he will make a statement on the matter.**

Dear Deputy Browne,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position:

- There are 71 Community CAMHS teams with 707.49 WTEs. (November 2019)
- 2 Day & Adolescent programmes with 13.56 WTEs. (December 2018)
- 3 Liaison Teams with 36.26 WTEs. (December 2018)
- 4 Specialist Inpatient Units with 198.2 WTEs. (December 2018)
- 3 MHID Teams with 12.1 WTEs. (December 2018)
