Waiting Time	No. of Children
Waiting <12 months	206
Waiting >12 months	244

^{*}Please note it is not possible to provide waiting figures broken down into greater than 24, 36 and 48 months as they are not recorded in this area.

Please be assured that Management from all areas and personnel from Audiology Services monitor the waiting list on an ongoing basis in the context of available resources and prioritisation criteria.
