The RCSI Hospital Group has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. Having reviewed the matter, the following outlines the position.

Services provided:

Out-patient Department Services, Theatre, Day Services, Diagnostic Services and Local Injury Unit.

In-patient services:

Rehabilitation Services - 20 Beds

Step-down Services - 11 Beds

Day care services:

Minor Procedures in General Surgery, Urology & ENT. Endoscopy Services. Haemochromotisis
Screening & Monitoring with Venesection Procedures.

Out-patient clinics:

Medicine, Surgery, ENT, Genito-Urinary Medicine, Antenatal, Gynaecology, Orthopaedics, Heart failure, Cardiac Rehabilitation, Pulmonary rehabilitation, Palliative care, Respiratory, Diabetic clinic
Paediatrics, Urology, Dietetics, Warfarin, Endocrinology, Developmental Dysplasia of the Hip.

Monaghan Hospital continues to provide ambulatory care and out-patient services.

To note, in February of this year 5 additional step-down beds were brought online, bring the total number to 11.
