The HSE are committed to supporting mothers to continue breastfeeding on return to work in line with WHO and HSE infant feeding recommendations and action 3.2 in the HSE Breastfeeding in a Healthy Ireland - Health Service Breastfeeding Action Plan 2016-2021.

The HSE Breastfeeding Implementation Group have drafted a HSE Staff Breastfeeding in the Workplace policy. The policy proposes that HSE employees will be supported to breastfeed until their child's second birthday through the provision of time, space and support.

The policy will be approved through established senior management sign off processes and union engagement fora.
