The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The redevelopment of St Joseph's Community Hospital, Stranorlar and Ramelton Community Hospital is included in the HSE Capital Plan. An application for funding in 2019 is part of the capital bid submitted by HSE Estates North West.

The HSE 2019 Capital Plan is currently being finalised and it is intended to proceed with the procurement of a Design Team for both projects this year, subject to availability of funding.


