The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have reviewed the matter and the following is the current position.

I can confirm that Waterford/Wexford Mental Health Services continue to engage with the Mental Health Commission (MHC) and takes very seriously any concerns raised by them. Correspondence received from the MHC are reviewed by the Quality & Patient Safety Committee who meet on a monthly basis. Corrective and Preventative Actions plans are in place and are continuously updated. These action plans are returned to the MHC as per their requirements. The Quality & Patient Safety Committees are made up of representatives from each discipline working in the approved centres and is chaired by the Service Manager.
