**PQ 29920/19**

**“To ask the Minister for Health the number of respite hours provided for adolescents with an intellectual disability in County Galway in each of the years from 2008 to 2018 in tabular form”.**

Dear Deputy Rabbitte,

I refer to PQ 29920 uploaded on the PAD System on 5<sup>th</sup> July 2019 and due for response on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2019 regarding representations that you have made to the Minister for Health concerning “the number of respite hours provided for adolescents with an intellectual disability in County Galway in each of the years from 2008 to 2018 in tabular form”. The HSE has been requested to reply directly to you on this matter. The following response outlines the position.

I wish to advise you that respite data collected for individuals with an intellectual disability does not have a separate category for adolescent respite on the national Key Performance Indicator (KPI) I.T. Metadata System. Adolescent respite is included with the children’s respite figures and I wish to draw your attention to response issued to PQ 29919/19 wherein that information was contained in tabular format as outlined in the table below.

In this regard, the table below details the children’s respite provided from 2008 to 2014 inclusive. Please note the significant drop in bed nights from 2011 is primarily a reflection of the change from residential centre based respite model to a home sharing model of respite.



The Key Performance Indicator templates were amended nationally in 2015 changing the data that is collected in respect of respite services. In this regard, detailed below is the respite data available in respect of children in County Galway for 2015 to 2018 inclusive.
