And if he will make a statement on the matter”

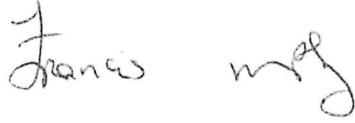
Dear Deputy Murphy,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

1. The number of persons waiting to access occupational therapy adult services in County Roscommon to date - **196**
2. The number on waiting lists for priority one, two and three cases, respectively –
Priority 1’s - 20, Priority 2’s - 176, we do not hold Priority 3’s.
3. The number of children waiting to access occupational therapy children's services in the county - **226**
4. The average waiting periods - **Waiting time ranges from 12 weeks to 36 months.**
