Dear Deputy O'Reilly,


The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The mission of the national stroke programme is to shape the delivery of better care through better use of resources. The vision is to design standardised models for the delivery of integrated clinical care and to embed sustained clinical operational management of the integrated pathway.

There are some capital initiatives relating to stroke services that Estates are aware of that are included in the 2019 Capital Plan submitted to the Department of Health (DOH) in last week. These include

- The provision of stroke rehabilitation services in the National Rehabilitation Hospital Redevelopment (120 Beds) currently in construction
- Stroke rehabilitation services will be provided in a number of the Rehabilitation/Step Down beds being provided as part of the CNU HIQA Compliance programme
- The Neuro Thrombectomy Unit in Beaumont Hospital – design to commence in 2019
