The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply to you directly in the context of the representation referenced above, the following outlines the situation;

I wish to advise that we are running additional lists at weekends, both Saturdays & Sundays and this has significantly reduced the numbers waiting and the length of time.

We have a Service Level Agreement with an external institution and we outsource over 100 scans to this unit per month. This gives us scope to ensure our P.1s are scanned within an acceptable timeframe.

Under Winter Plan we also outsourced via the National Treatment Purchase Fund. In addition, we are currently in the process of putting a tender process in place to install a relocatable MRI scanner on site to help manage with the waiting list.
