RE PQ 12091/19: To ask the Minister for Health the waiting time for a speech and language therapy appointment for children in County Meath.

Dear Deputy Byrne,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question and Representation, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and outline the position as follows.

Waiting times vary throughout the county as a result of variances in staff vacancies.

Maximum waiting time in social care is 112 weeks. Social care team referrals which include SLT have increased from 211referrals in 2013 to 425 referrals in 2018. Presently there are two approved vacancies on the social care team which are with the National Recruitment Service for recruitment and the process for filling these posts has commenced.

Maximum waiting time in primary care is 54 weeks. Presently there are three staff on maternity leave and an appointment is pending for one of these posts, which will help address the current 54 week waiting period. Of the remaining two vacant posts, one post is presently live with the National Recruitment Service and the other has been approved for forwarding to the National Recruitment Service for recruitment.
