To ask the Minister for Health when Enniscorthy, New Ross and Gorey Primary Care Centres will move to advanced planning stage; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Browne,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which was submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have examined the matter and the following response outlines the position.

The HSE has issued Letters of Intent to Developers in respect of Gorey, Enniscorthy and New Ross Primary Care Centres. The relevant Developer will work in close liaison with the Estates and Service personnel with the aim of finalising a schedule of accommodation for each individual Primary Care Centre. However, it is the responsibility of the Developer to progress the development of the Primary Care Centre to the planning stage.

Agreement to Lease has not been reached for any of these areas.
