Dear Deputy Durkan,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in regard to your parliamentary question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The Health Service Executive (HSE) acknowledges that reduced staffing levels in the Speech and Language Therapy (SLT) can affect outcomes for children waiting on the services. Whilst individuals on maternity leave in the SLT service in this community organisation are not automatically replaced, where possible clinicians are temporarily employed to replace individuals on maternity leave.

The HSE continue to monitor staffing levels in the SLT service as a priority and all attempts are made to address service provision for children to ensure their needs are met.
