To ask the Minister for Health if the cost of compartmentalised medication trays are covered under the medical card scheme; and if he will make a statement on the matter. -Michael Moynihan

Dear Deputy Moynihan,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (Reference 43349/19), which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

There are no reimbursement arrangements under the GMS and Community Drugs Schemes for the filling of blister packs. The Irish Pharmacy Representative Organisation made a proposal to the Department of Health previously in this regard but it was not approved for funding. It is entirely acceptable for a pharmacy to offer, as a quality initiative, to provide a patient's medicines in such systems. However, it is a pharmacy arrangement with the patient and is not a state funded service.
