"To ask the Minister for Health the estimated capital and current funding required to have electrophysiology activity in the cardiovascular laboratory at the Mater Hospital increased on site from three to five days per week."

I refer to the above Parliamentary Question seeking the estimated capital and current funding required to have electrophysiology activity in the cardiovascular laboratory at the Mater Misericordiae University Hospital increased, which has been referred to the Ireland East Hospital Group for direct response.

I have had this matter examined and am advised that the costs would include pay and nonpay and are estimated at €2,465,338 per annum. This figure is calculated based on an average cost across a range of Electrophysiology procedures and salaries at mid-point on salary scale
