The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for response.

I wish to advise the Health Service Executive's Recruitment operating model and information systems are currently under review to address capacity challenges that exist whilst supporting Government Policy and the implementation of Slaintecare.

HBS recruit collates information on recruitment centrally, but it does not contain information on local recruitment campaigns. Therefore at the time of writing it is not possible to provide the information requested, as such the data requested in the above question is unfortunately not available.
