PQ Ref PQ 39049/19**To ask the Minister for Health the number of tubal ligations carried out on public patients in each of the years 2016 to 2018, in tabular form.

PQ 39051/19** To ask the Minister for Health the public hospitals that provide tubal ligation and vasectomy services.

Dear Deputy O'Reilly,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

As PQ 39049 and 39051 are closely related, the National Women and Infants Health Programme (NWIHP) felt it appropriate to answer the PQs together.

Data was sought and provided from the HSE Hospital Inpatient Enquiry (HIPE). Please note that HIPE reports only inpatient and day-case day. HIPE has advised that there is no procedure code for 'tubal ligation' and so data for the following three female sterilisation procedures were reported rather than solely 'tubal ligation':

- 1. Laparoscopic sterilisation
- 2. Sterilisation via vaginal approach
- 3. Sterilisation via open abdominal approach

The following table displays the total public patient discharges nationally with any of the three mentioned sterilisation procedures between 2016 and 2018.
