To ask the Minister for Health the reason a suitable location for a community alcohol treatment service has not be secured (details supplied); the way the allocated funding for the inoperative service is being used; if he has engaged with the HSE regarding resumption of this service; when he expects this service to recommence; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Shortall,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

HSE Community Healthcare West wishes to state that a suitable premises in Galway has been identified for an Alcohol Treatment Centre. HSE Estates are currently in the final stages of negotiations with the landlord on agreeing terms of the lease. It is anticipated that this process will be completed by March 2021 at the latest. As soon as the lease is signed, staff already interviewed will be offered posts. It is anticipated that the service will be in a position to accept clients shortly after this.

The provision of this service is a top priority for Community Healthcare West and all efforts to ensure that it is up and running in the shortest possible time are being made.
