"To ask the Minister for Health if there is an emergency medicine consultant present on a 24-hour basis in each emergency department across all acute hospitals; and if not, when there will be"

Dear Deputy Kelly

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

There are at present 26 24 hour Adult Emergency Departments as per list below. The 3 Emergency Departments operated by Children's Hospital Ireland are additional to same.

The hospitals that have 24/7/365 Emergency Departments but do not have 24/7/365 access to Consultants in Emergency Medicine, are those highlighted in blue below:

Where an Emergency Department does not have access to Consultants in Emergency Medicine on a 24/7/365 basis, clinical governance arrangements for these Emergency Departments are complemented by Consultant Physician cover.



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Emergency Departments are supported by a wider team, which includes, but is not exclusive to; non-consultant hospital doctors (NCHDs), Registrars, nursing staff, health and social care professionals.

The future configuration, role and function of Emergency Departments and their associated staffing arrangements is expected to be informed by a range of strategies including the Trauma Strategy for Ireland https://www.gov.ie/en/publication/c8640e-a-trauma-system-for-ireland-report-of-the-trauma-steering-group/ and the HSE's Emergency Medicine Programme https://www.hse.ie/eng/about/who/cspd/ncps/emp/. The learning from COVID-19 will also be a key influence on future direction.
