Dear Deputy Daly,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (refined on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2020), which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The National Ambulance Service (NAS) continuously evaluates its services aligned to available resources and activity levels. It is not a static service and as such deploys its resources in a dynamic manner and operates on an area and national basis as opposed to a local basis. The dynamic deployment of ambulance resources ensures that the nearest appropriate resource is mobilised to the location of the incident. If required, the NAS will utilise the dynamic dispatch of resources from surrounding stations to an incident.

In relation to the response times for the month of March this can be attributed to additional call demand on services in relation to clinical conditions including COVID-19.
