As part of the Covid19 emergency response the HSE have refurbished three units previously vacated in St. Mary Hospital in the Phoenix Park. The overall capital cost of these extensive works are in the region of €6.0m. No external bodies were involved in that funding of the capital funding for the extensive works undertaken in St. Mary Hospital in the Phoenix Park as part of Covid19 emergency response.
