The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The National Key Performance Indicators (KPI) process requires the capture of information in a specified format. The figures below reflect Community Healthcare Organisation (CHO) Dublin North City and County (DNCC) for June 2020 and are the most up to date available under the KPI process.
