Dear Deputy Wynne,

I refer to your Parliamentary Question in relation to the above *“To ask the Minister for Health the number of persons awaiting a speech and language appointment in CHO3 by county; the number waiting less than 3, 3 to 6, 6 to 12 and more than 12 months in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter.*

The table below outlines the numbers of persons waiting for a Speech & Language Therapy initial assessment appointment as per our preliminary data up to the end of June 2020 by county. The waiting time categorisations collected differ from the Parliamentary Question asked, however please see below the data available. All referrals received are clinically triaged and are prioritised based on the persons clinical presentation. The Speech & Language Therapy Services provide all therapies on an appointment basis.
