To ask the Minister for Health if the deal with an organisation (details supplied) for additional testing Covid-19 protected the samples which were taken from persons; and if the genetic material and data cannot be used for anything other than Covid-19 testing or held for an inordinate length of time - Louise O'Reilly.

PQ 11480/20

To ask the Minister for Health the health facilities that have transferred genetic material and data to a company (details supplied) to date; and if all patients that had their data transferred consented to this transfer or if it was transferred without their consent and unbeknownst to them - Louise O'Reilly.
