Dear Deputy Shortall,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The Health Service Executive has an appointed Data Protection Officer for the entire HSE covering all HSE run acute, community, corporate and other services. Accordingly, HSE hospitals do not have an individual designated Data Protection Officer.

In addition, there are four Deputy Data Protection Officers who work in regional Consumer Affairs Departments and manage data protection matters locally under the guidance of the Data Protection Officer for the HSE. Their contact details and processes by which requests relating to data protection can be made is available in the HSE's Data Protection policy published on the HSE website <u>https://www.hse.ie/eng/gdpr/hse-data-protection-policy/</u>.

Each of the Voluntary (Section 38) Hospitals is a Data Controller in its own right and is responsible for its own GDPR management. Information on making data protection requests to these Data Protection Officers is available from the individual hospital website.
