I refer to your recent PQ to the Minister for Health in which you asked 'the number of spinal fusion patients currently waiting less than 4, 4 to 8 and more than 8 months for treatment in hospitals (details supplied); and if he will provide the same information for other spinal patients

Details Supplied: for Our Lady's Children's Hospital, Crumlin and Temple Street Children's University Hospital for the end of February 2020 or the latest date available

Children's Health Ireland Response

I wish to apologise for the length of time responding to your PQ, as I sure will you understand we have been extremely busy dealing with the many issues which have arisen during the current pandemic.

As part as an overall investment from National Service Planning money, the funding for orthopaedic services allocated in 2018 with posts phased in 2019 ensured the enhancement of the entire orthopaedic service

An additional General Orthopaedic Surgeon is due to commence in Q3 2020 for CHI at Crumlin and CHI at Tallaght. This post is for general orthopaedic and trauma surgery to support the large volume of patients waiting and will further reduce waiting times for children for general orthopaedic outpatient appointment, including scoliosis. Approximately 20% of patients on the inpatient waiting list are waiting for a scoliosis procedure with 80% of children waiting for general orthopaedic procedures. These paediatric orthopaedic consultants will form part of Children's Health Ireland's consultant team and will join a cross-city team of paediatric outpatient who will deliver services at Crumlin and Temple Street as well as evolving role of the Paediatric Outpatient and Urgent Care Centre at Connolly which is part of the overall vision for a cross city paediatric orthopaedic service in CHI.

* No of patients suspended from the waiting list, as patient is temporarily unavailable for surgery as per the parents or are clinically unsuitable for their procedure as per the clinician. This includes all suspensions (hospital or patient initiated)
