## PQ 3744/20

To ask the Minister for Health the status of promised funding for a centre (the Windmill Theraputic Centre) for adults with mild and moderate disabilities; and if he will request the HSE and Pobal to restore funding to the service.

Dear Deputy Mythen,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

*I have reviewed the matter and the following is the current position.* 

Following significant engagement between Windmill Therapeutic Training Unit and HSE Disability Services the additional funding requirement of €110,000 per annum through the loss of Pobal funding has now been resolved and the HSE has identified the additional funding going forward into 2020.
