Re PQ 4737 20: To ask the Minister for Health the estimated cost of employing 1,000 additional practice, community care and public health nurses; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Carroll MacNeill,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. Your PQ above has been referred to me for response.

Practice Nurses is not a recognised HSE Post or grade position however, for indicative purposes the estimated annual cost of hiring an additional 1,000 Staff Nurses (Grade Code 2135) is €53.0M.

Community Care Nurses is not a recognised HSE Post or grade position however, for indicative purposes the estimated annual cost of hiring an additional 1,000 Staff Nurses Community Mental Health (Grade Code 2301) is €70.4M.

The estimated annual cost of hiring an additional 1,000 Public Health Nurses (Grade Code 2828) is €60.5M.

All estimates were provided by the National Pay Unit of the National Finance Division and are calculated using the mid points of the HSE pay scales. From this, an average annual fully burdened salary is calculated (i.e. including average premium and employers PRSI) for the Grade and position noted.

In addition to the pay costs above it is reasonable to assume that there are other non-pay costs associated with the recruitment process i.e. advertising, interview boards, possible travel expenses etc. which would also be incurred. There may also be ancillary support services associated with the new posts arising from the implied additional activity that would be undertaken as a result of the increased number of staff. Some of these services may be drawn from existing cost pools however there may be incremental costs incurred i.e. facilities costs, admin support, medical support teams etc. These have not been included in the estimates above.

The estimated annual pay costs of employing additional staff must be considered in this context.
