**Dear Deputy**

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Cheeverstown House is working closely with Public Health and continues to implement Infection Prevention and Control guidance to minimise the risk of COVID-19 transmission within the facility.

There will be a phased reintroduction of respite and day services when assessed as safe to do so by the organisation. However, these services will be delivered in a different arrangement than heretofore as the service will comply with measures such as safe social distancing.

Cheeverstown is committed to the health and wellbeing of both service users and staff in this present COVID-19 pandemic.
