(Details) - Covid Testing Centre in Athlone

Dear Deputy Kerrane,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and outline response as follows.

The test centre in Athlone closed in June 2020 as a result of reduced demand. In line with national strategy for the provision of Covid Test Centres in Ireland there is one test centre in County Westmeath which is located in Mullingar which provides a testing service for all clients in Westmeath. There is also a testing centre in Longford and Tullamore, which individuals may attend if they find it more convenient.

The national ambulance service provide mobile testing for those individuals who are not able to attend for testing, and this can be organised as required
