Dear Deputy Mitchell,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Tonlegee Road Primary Care Centre (Edenmore) was built as part of the HSE's National Strategy to develop purpose built primary care centres, delivering health services to local communities. Building works are at the last stages of completion and it is expected that staff will start to move into the centre in early December 2020 with services starting to operate in the first quarter of 2021. It is envisaged there will be an official opening of the centre in 2021, however, no date is set at this time.

The project is being delivered under the HSE's Primary Care Operational Lease Mechanism and the cost of the new building is a matter for the landlord.
