The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and outline response as follows.

Please note the enquiry does not define the term special needs so therefore it is difficult to provide accurate data to the question.

The numbers presented are those currently on waiting lists for the Senior Dental Surgeon's in Louth and Meath. However they are an underestimate of the number of special care patients waiting for treatment, as all HSE dentists treat special care patients, but there is currently no way to identify these patients within the national dental electronic patient record system.

LOUTH/MEATH ORTHODONTICS

It is not possible to provide you with figures for special needs patients referred to our list as we do not categorise the patients in that way.

They are categorised by the Modified IOTN as per the 2007 HSE guidelines.

MIDLANDS ORTHODONTICS

The Midlands Orthodontic Service does not collect information on whether or not a person on the waiting list has a special need. Waiting lists for services are prioritised on the basis of their clinical need for Orthodontic services following an Orthodontic assessment.
