I refer to the above Parliamentary Question which has been referred by the Minister for Health to the Health Service Executive for direct response.

For each circumstance, a public health risk assessment is carried out that considers the factors including mask wearing, space and duration of time spent, social distancing etc. The fact whether services are essential services is also taken into account.

This risk assessment then informs the public health advice for that particular circumstance.
