Dear Deputy Murphy

Response:

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The recent COVID 19 outbreaks are reported to Acute Operations, HPSC and appropriate public health offices. These outbreaks are being managed in line with the HSE protocol *Notification of Infectious Disease Outbreaks to Departments of Public Health in acute hospital setting- Declaration of an Outbreak and Closure of an Outbreak* which is available at https://www.hse.ie/eng/about/who/healthwellbeing/our-priority-programmes/hcai/resources/general/noid-declaration-and-closure-of-an-outbreak-acutes

In line with national protocol, Outbreak control teams (OCTs) are established and records of key discussions, findings, decisions and actions are retained following OCT meetings. The General Manager /CEOs in respective hospitals are accountable for the overall management of the outbreak working closely with public health advisors and infection prevention control professionals.

I can assure you that the management of all infection outbreaks is prioritised and overseen by Acute Operations team supported by the national HSE AMRIC (Antimicrobial resistance and Infection control team) in the context of the HSE performance and accountability framework and public health policies.

I trust this answers your question to your satisfaction.
