Dear Deputy Dillon,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

There are a number of capital developments both in progress or under consideration for delivery at Mayo University Hospital (MUH). The proposal to conduct a feasibility study for an additional 50-bed ward at MUH will be progressed following completion of other works and in the context of the overall plan for works at MUH.

In 2020, significant works have been undertaken at MUH including upgrade works on 3 wards and a new modular Medical Assessment Unit. Other projects at various stages include electrical upgrade works (at planning stage), HSSD (Hospital Sterile Services Department) reconfiguration (at design stage), proposed expansion of the Emergency Department (ED) and reconfiguration works (scope being finalised) and upgrade interim modular treatment space (works completed for installation).
