Dear Deputy Shortall,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for response.

The Treatment Benefit Scheme is run by the Department of Social Protection (DSP) and provides dental, optical and aural services to qualified people.

The Treatment Benefit Scheme is available to insured workers, the self-employed and retired people who have the required number of PRSI Contributions.

Under the Treatment Benefit Scheme, you may qualify for:

- Dental benefit
- Optical benefit
- Hearing aids

As this is a policy matter, the HSE is not in a position to comment further.
