To ask the Minister for Health if he will provide a summary of the annual mental health budget in each of the years 2015 to 2019; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Naughten,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The table below details the mental health budget for each of the years 2015 – 2019 on mental health services. The budget figure for each year includes the PfG funding provided in that year but is shown on a line separately for information.
