Dear Deputy Flanagan,

I refer to your representation "To ask the Minister for Health if his attention has been drawn to the fact that CHO 8 is experiencing a long waiting time for approval and delivery of home help services; and if he will make a statement on the matter, and wish to respond as follows

Home Support applications are considered in each of the six counties of CHO 8 on a weekly basis by assessment teams. Home Support hours are approved/refused or referred to other care pathways. Once a decision is made to approve hours, then these services are set up in the home directly by HSE Staff or by agencies working on behalf of the HSE, services are in place within days of the home support team making it's decision. Any delays incurred are generally due to carer availability as we do have some black spot areas where we cannot access carers. Funding is not currently an issue for CHO 8 and we will receive an additional funding allocation as part of the 2020/2021 Winter Plan. We have noted that the governments' Covid pandemic payment has impacted on availability of carer's within some agencies working on behalf of the HSE.
